East Lyme Board of Education Finance, Facilities and Operations (FFO) Committee Meeting

Monday, February 13, 2012 9:45 p.m.

The meeting began at 9:45 PM

- <u>Review ELPS Special Revenue Accounts</u> Special revenue accounts were reviewed. These funds include the high school pool, before and after care programs, a preschool program and periodic funds for a specific special purpose. Questions arose on the specific policy regarding these revenues. It was suggested that the policy committee report back to FFO on the specifics in the near future.
- <u>Review Monthly Budget Summary</u> The monthly budget summary was discussed. Don Meltabarger reported that the instructional improvements of \$80,990 should be back on track in March '12. FFO would like to make a motion to approve a transfer of \$120,000 out of workers compensation account into non-instructional account at the next BOE meeting on 2/27/12.
- 3. <u>Proposed EL Aquatic Center's Fitness Room Floor Replacement Project</u> Steve Hargis spoke about the need to replace the aquatic floor as a means of updating obsolete equipment and obsolete flooring. The flooring will be replaced with an overlay on top. Bids are coming in at approximately \$16,000 \$20,000. As part of a 3 way cost sharing model, ELHS, The Athletic Dept and The Fitness/Aquatic program would each pay \$7,000. Jaypro's bid was for \$21,000. A request will be made for \$7,000 out of the capital reserve fund for flooring.
- 4. <u>Proposed EL Aquatic Center Boiler Replacement Project</u> Discussion of the replacement of the aquatic boiler took place. Reportedly, the 13 year old boiler which recently sprung a leak, was repaired. However, due to corrosion, it was recommended that the entire boiler be replaced within the year. The estimated cost would be between \$50,000-\$60,000. Don will check into natural gas options.
- Proposed Reduction in EL Aquatic Center's Fitness Room Fee for ELHS Students Opinions on student fees were shared. There was a consensus to reducing ELHS student fees from \$4.00 to \$2.00.
