905	Family Service Association	6,301	The agency provides East Lyme residents in need with health care services which include dental care, adult and pediatric primary medical care and mental health counseling and psychotherapy.
906	Homeless Shelter/NL Hospitality	3,000	Due to a special presentation during the 2008/09 fiscal year, the Boards began to support this facility. Provides a regional resource for homeless neighbors including an overnight emergency shelter and a daytime hospitality center that helps link people to needed services. Letter attached.
911	El Cemeteries	1,500	Funding request is to preserve the Historic Cemeteries located throughout town.
912	TVCCA	1,500	Agency provides various types of services to East Lyme residents. For the period October 1, 2013 through September 30, 2014 the total in services to the Town of East Lyme was \$704,209. Letter Attached.
