This year a new Harbor Master and Deputy Harbor Master were appointed. We also instituted a new mooring permit process, which includes a \$25.00 fee for mooring permits. The Harbor Master and Deputy Harbor Master will need to be compensated for their time managing the new mooring program, which is expected to include processing permit applications, inspecting moorings, validating the location of moorings, and updating/managing the mooring database. 415 5.750 Personnel Services Total 200 Services - Contracted/Operations 225 Maintenance of \$2500 of this is paid to support operation of the Pump out boat in the Niantic River and Niantic Bay. Harbor The remainder is used for maintenance of navigational markers, administration of mooring permits, mooring permit tags and other harbor management operations. We request a reallocation of \$2000 from our Personnel Services (100) account to cover additional costs associated with implementating and adminstering the new mooring permit program, which would unclude items such as removal of abondanded and delinguent moorings, and expenses incurred by the Harbor Master and Deputy Harbor Master (e.g., boat fuel).
