# Director's Report May 1, 2014

#### McCook Point Park:

- Beach passes will go on sale Monday, May 5.
- Age appropriate signage has been installed for the Playscapes
- Touch-A-Truck is scheduled for Saturday, May 17 from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.
- A 30x60 tent has been installed in upper picnic area, the tent will be used to replace the Pavilion once construction begins on the boardwalk.
- Beaches will be staffed with Gate Attendants starting Saturday, May 24. I would like to
  officially open the beaches on Friday, June 20 with Lifeguards.

## **Athletic Facilities:**

- Restroom facility for Vets will go out to bid on Friday.
- Fields are in great shape maintenance crew continues to do an outstanding job.
- We are monitoring a proposed bill in the state senate that would eliminate the use of pesticides on school grounds for High Schools and all municipal parks. There is a present ban on pesticide use on grounds for K-8<sup>th</sup> grade schools. We are experiencing a gradual worsening of our turf areas at Little League, Middle School Soccer and PeeWee Football because of the present ban.
- We have hosted two War at the Shore AAU baseball tournaments to date.
- Maintenance crew will be installing safety netting behind the Lacrosse goals that are near the walking path.

#### **Budget:**

- Our 2014-2015 Operating Budget was cut by the Board of Finance in the amount of \$10,000.00. My recommendations for the cuts were as follows:
  - o \$3,500 from PT Seasonal Labor
  - o \$600.00 from Overtime
  - o \$1,000.00 from Equipment Maintenance
  - \$2,000 from Park and Field Maintenance
  - o \$300.00 from Telephones
  - o \$300.00 from Dues
  - \$500.00 from Miscellaneous Supplies
  - o \$1,500 from Materials
  - \$300.00 from Electricity
