Proposed Revisions to rates and charges for connection to and the use of the East Lyme
 Water System

Acting Chairman Seery called the Public Hearing to order at 6:32 PM. He noted that the notice had been published in the local newspaper, The Day with the Publisher's Certificate dated October 16, 2015 attached. They would hold the public hearing on the Sewer rate changes separately after the close of this public hearing.

Mr. Bragaw, Public Works Director noted that the proposed rates represent a 1½% increase and recapped that last year they had an 5% increase and that in years prior to that the increases also were quite substantial as they were trying to get back on track. He said that the main items here are the cost of electricity, wages and benefits and a new truck. He noted that the differences from the current rates are minimal.

Mr. Seery asked if there were any members of the public who wished to comment – There were none.

Ms. Russell asked about the current billing period and how they came out regarding revenues. Mr. Bragaw said that they came in a bit lower than expected. He noted that March was a very difficult month and they had for the first time in a long time read all of the meters. As they had previously estimated those that they could not read, this is sometimes the outcome as the adjustment is made when the meter is actually read. He said that this puts them on a good footing to have all of the meters read going forward.
