Proposed Revisions to rates and charges for connection to and the use of the East Lyme
 Sewer System

Acting Chairman Seery called the Public Hearing to order at 6:42 PM immediately following the previously scheduled Public Hearing on the Water rates. He noted that the notice had been published in the local newspaper, The Day with the Publisher's Certificate dated October 16, 2015 attached.

Mr. Bragaw, Public Works Director noted that the proposed rates represent a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ % increase and recapped that last year they had an 8% increase and that in years prior to that the increases also were quite substantial as they were doing poorly. This proposed increase indicates that they are putting themselves in a better position.

Mr. Mingo asked about the past borrowing and if it had been paid back.

Mr. Bragaw explained the borrowing and that it had not all been paid back however they now had it under control and on a program.

Ms. Russell asked about the sewer revenues and how the most recent billing had come in.

Mr. Bragaw said that they were actually higher than projected as the flows coming out were high.

Mr. Seery called for a motion to close this Public Hearing.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN of a Public Hearing to be held by the East Lyme Water and Sewer Commission at the East Lyme Town Hall on Tuesday, October 27, 2015 to consider proposed revisions to rates and charges for connection to and the use of the East Lyme Sewerage system. This sewer rate public hearing will commence at 6:30 P.M. The proposed revised sewer rates and charges are as follows:

Rate Application for Connection Permit Class 'A'- Residential Class 'B'- Multi Family and Commercial Class 'C'- Industrial \$100.00 \$200.00 \$500.00 Demolition/Disconnect-Any Class \$50.00 Sale of Stocked Material Cost, incl. shipping, plus 12% admin fee Inspection Services **During Normal Working Hours** \$65.00/hour \$97.50/hour After Normal Working Hours Usage, based on metered water readings at billing intervals Metered \$7.10/1,000 gallons \$177.50 Unmetered, per six 6 month period

These revised rates and charges shall be effective on November 1, 2015. Rates for usage shall be payable at six month intervals. All other rates shall be payable at the time services are rendered
