Town Meeting Moderator Gene Cushman called the Special Town Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Mr. Cushman led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Karen Galbo, Assistant Town Clerk, read the Call of the Meeting (Items 1, 2, and 4 were not read)

Ron Rando asked as a point of order why Items 1, 2, and 4 were not going to be heard tonight.

To consider and act upon a resolution entitled "Resolution Making An Appropriation In The Amount of \$139,522 For Brownfield Remediation And Construction Of Park Improvements And Authorizing The Issuance Of \$139,522 Bonds Of The Town To Meet Said Appropriation And Pending The Issuance Thereof The Making Of Temporary Borrowings For Such Purpose".
