<u>Approval of Minutes</u>: The minutes of the February 21<sup>st</sup> meeting were read. Missy Miko moved to approve them, seconded by MaryCatherine Solomkin. Minutes unanimously approved.

## Old Business:

- Memorial Day Float: The theme will be "Farming the Sea". Tim Londregan will have his boat at St.
  Agnes and will pull it with his truck. Nancy Kalal will make +/- 2 eight foot banners. Additionally, we will have 2-3 tractors in the parade. Tom Kalal will not be able to bring his tractor if he's haying.
- Open Farm Day: Shaping up as follows: Tours will be offered from 10:00 am through 2:00 pm.
  Hayrides will depart from the town hall parking lot where Missy Miko and her goat Zoey will
  welcome people. Stop #1 Cini Park under the bridge. Staffed by Sam & Kyle Corey. Stop #2 Low
  Tide Louey's / Tim Londregan's barge. Stop #3 Rickety Picket, staffed by Sally Uden and
  MaryCatherine Solomkil, with a "pollinator presentation" by Diana Earl, Master Gardener.

Mark Christianson's and Tom Kalal's tractors will run opposite each other with Nancy Kalal as the attendant on one trailer and Thomas Hall on the other. Bruce Solomkin will be at the Blackhawk to help out.

Signs will be silkscreened by Thomas Hall and Bruce Solomkin. Tom Kalal will get us on the town hall Marquee. Mark Christianson will get the word out to Discover East Lyme & Channel 22

<u>Reports & Communications:</u> June 9<sup>th</sup> is the Samuel Smith House's open house and Missy Miko has been asked to bring her goats & also to sell her homemade goat's milk soaps.

<u>Motion to Adjourn:</u> A motion to adjourn was made by Tom Kalal at 7:20 PM and seconded by Missy Miko. The committee voted unanimously in favor of adjournment.
