Selectman Dagle reported the Board of Finance had passed the budget, which will go to referendum on May 24th or May 25th.

VI. PENDING APPLICATIONS -

A. Application of Edward J. Watson, Applicant/Owner; 3-lot subdivision of land located at 31 Walnut Hill Road.

Ann Cicchiello stated she had walked the property with some difficulty.

James Bernardo, LS, provided a brief overview/refresher on the application on behalf of Mr. Watson.

Joseph R. Theroux, Soil Scientist, submitted his report to the Agency.

Phyllis Berger asked about the type of driveway the lots would have. Jim Bernardo responded. He also noted that the existing home is on lot 2, where there is also a swimming pool, but no ponds, the only open water is Cranberry Meadow.

The subdivision deeds will reference wetlands. The driveway will split off the existing driveway.

Harry Clarke moved to find no significant impact in the Application of Edward J. Watson, Applicant/Owner for a 3-lot subdivision of land located at 31 Walnut Hill Road. Second by Ann Cicchiello. Motion passed 6-0-0.

C. Enforcement

 Cease, Desist and Restore Order; 13 Green Valley Lakes Rd; Thomas & Kristen Chantrell, Owner; Installation of a dock which encroaches approximately 20-feet into a watercourse located on an abutting property and the clearing, grading, removal and deposition of material on the land within 100 feet of a watercourse without an Inland Wetlands Permit.

Kristen Chantrell, Owner advised the Agency that they will remove the violation by removing the dock. Mr. Goeschel recommended and suggested the dock be removed at a time of low flow. The Agency offered a deadline of August 31, 2018.

Harry Clarke moved to amend the Cease, Desist and Restore order to provide a deadline of August 31, 2018 for the removal of the violation at 13 Green Valley Lake Rd, East Lyme. Ted Koch second. Motion passed 6-0-0.
