- 1. Sidewalk has been added from current Boston Post Rd sidewalk to street side of building
- 2. Pedestrian way stripping has been been added parallel and perpendicular to the driveway side (east side) of building.
- 3. Speed bumps have been added at the entry to the site near the building and at the rear exit from the parking lot
- 4. A "Caution Slowdown Pedestrian Traffic" sign has been placed at the entry to the building.

- Proposed sidewalk from Boston Post Road to front of the building: No issue; a sidewalk detail has already been included on Sheet C-60 of the Drawing Set.
 Striping in front and perpendicular to the building: No issue.
 Signage for pedestrian area; caution sign with 10 mph speed limit it is my opinion that the small size of this site does not justify setting a speed limit sign. During busy times, even 10 mph may be an excessive rate of speed. I do encourage a "caution" sign be st and offer the example below as option to be considered:
- 4. Three speed bumps in front of the building: No objection, however the short distance between the speed bumps may cause for more driver distraction. One speed bump and properly placed "Caution" sign(s) should be sufficient.
