Mr. Mulholland,

The East Lyme Public Library in conjunction with the East Lyme Historical Society requests the approval of a Special Permit for the use of the site as follows:

The main (1st) floor will be open to the public for guided and unguided tours. On a typical day it is anticipated that no more than 2 volunteers will be on the first floor and visitation is expected to be very light.

The second floor will not be open to the public. It will house mainly archives available for research by appointment only. Several volunteers will periodically be there working on organizing the archival collection. Board meetings of up to 12 people also take place upstairs.

There currently exists 23 parking spaces.

As this is Town property alcoholic beverages are not allowed without a special exception from the Board of Selectman. Any possible fundraising that might occur on the premises will be under a separate approval whereby added parking on the same property (Flanders School) could be available under this separate approval.

It is requested that the 10 feet landscaped setback buffer be waived because of existing physical conditions.

There may be occasional student visits, when it is anticipated that the students will walk from Flanders School or dropped off by bus or other group transportation.
