All cellular and land line 911 calls originating in East Lyme, and on 195 in the East Lyme area, are answsered by Dispatchers for the Town of East Lyme. Aside from operating as the PSAP, the EL Dispatch Center provides full service Fire/EMS/Police dispatch services for East Lyme Emergency Service agencies, as well as monitoring and notifications for multiple Town of East Lyme governmental departments. The Dispatch center currently employs 8 full time employees who, suplemented by part time employees, provide 2 dispatchers on duty at all times.
