1. Permits are not required for the following:
 - A. Tents used exclusively for recreational camping purposes.
 - B. Tents less than 350 square feet (total area).
 - C. Tents 900 square feet and smaller (total area) when occupied by fewer than 50 persons, which have no heating appliances, no installed electrical service and are erected for fewer than 72 hours.
2. Within a tent, the tent supplier or homeowner can plug in their own equipment, including exit signs and lighting. **An Electrical Permit Is Required.**
3. Lightning protection, such as ground rods, is NOT REQUIRED for a tent. A tent is not the place to be during a storm.
4. Grounds Rods are required ONLY AT A GENERATOR and shall be grounded effectively to the generator. Metal tent poles in contact with electrical devices or cables must be bonded to the electrical system ground.
5. Electric power taken from a dwelling shall use the dwelling's grounding system.
6. Lighting shall be protected by guards and kept away from combustible materials. NEC 305-4 (f) Festoon wiring is allowed in a tent (incandescent lamps are ok).
7. Lighting shall be kept high enough within the tent so as not to make contact with pedestrians.
8. The tent supplier or homeowner may do electric power directly from a generator with outlets and plug in cords. GFCI OUTLETS MUST BE AT THE TENT. **An Electrical Permit Is Required.**
9. The tent supplier or homeowner may do electric power from the sub-panel GFCI outlets to the interior of the tent. **An Electrical Permit Is Required.**
10. Electric power from house panel to sub-panel shall be installed by a qualified licensed electrical contractor. **An Electrical Permit Is Required.**
11. The sub-panel may be inside or outside the tent.
12. Nuisance tripping of GFCI can be eliminated by the use of short cords and less load per circuit.
13. NFPA 102 – open flame device is NOT ALLOWED – must have hurricane glass around flame.
14. Sterno type food warming devices are allowed in tents without a permit IF an approved holding device, which would keep them from falling over, supports them.
15. All tents with an occupant load greater than 50 persons shall have two (2) exits *
16. All tents that are required to have more than one (1) exit shall have approved exit signs. These do not have to be internally lit unless used at night, however, there must be back up power for illuminated signs. *

* Exception: Where tent has no sides and means of egress are obvious
