Correspondence

- On December 30, Michael Meinz sent a message to Corey Foster reporting a Facebook post by an East Lyme customer complaining about Internet speed. On January 2, a Breezeline technician found bad signal levels caused by a bad fitting on the ground block on the side of the customer's building. An inside appointment on January 3 was made to resolve any remaining issues and to test that all was fixed.
- On January 3, Michael Meinz mailed a letter to each of the nine chief elected officials reminding them of the requirements to appoint Cable TV Advisory Council members.

Public Comment

• Montville's Mayor Leonard G, Bunnell, Sr. asked about using the town's PEG channel for town meetings. Michael Meinz responded with a brief explanation of the PEGPETIA grant process and the overall design and operation of East Lyme's system for video recording and replay of town meetings. Further details will be shared at a future demonstration in East Lyme's townhall.

Breezeline

- Corey Foster explained that Breezeline offers a redundancy option based on 4G LTE.
- In response to a question about price promotions, he responded that Breezeline constantly evaluates the competition.
- A question was asked about Wi-Fi HotSpots. Corey said that he would provide a list of the Breezeline's existing Wi-Fi HotSpots.

SEC-TV

- Frank Facchini said that there are currently 36 Community Access shows.
- He would like to see a link to the SEC-TV website on each town's website.
- He asked that Advisory Council members identify the person in their town that can provide statistics on use of the town's cable TV channel.
