- 7. Determine what a dog park should consist of
 - a. How much area should be fenced in for large and small dogs?
 - b. How should entrances be configured?

 - e. Do we have to have water or can we ask those using the park to bring their own?

- 9. Rules for a dog park
 - a. Some common rules
 - b. All dogs must have a license. This ensures the dogs are vaccinated for rabies and encourages everyone to get a license for their dogs.
 - c. Noisy dogs should be removed by their owners.
 - d. Unruly dogs should be removed by their owners.
 - e. Dog and/or owners may be barred from the dog park if felt to be a danger to other dogs or owners.
 - f. Other rules.
 - g. Enforcement

- 10. Structure of long-term Dog Park Governance
 - a. Subcommittee of Parks and Recreation Commission to accept complaints, comments and adjust rules as needed.
 - b. Maintain web site with rules and other information about the Dog Park and dog related activities in East Lyme.
