East Lyme Senior Center IS TAKING APPLICATIONS

Applications for CEAP are accepted from September 1st through May 30th, 2025.

The Connecticut Energy Assistance Program (CEAP) is designed to help offset home energy costs of Connecticut's lower income households, specifically those households whose annual income falls at or below 60% of the state median income. Income guidelines are as follows:

60% of 2023 State Median Income Guidelines

Household Size	1	2	3	4	5	6	7	8

To fully process and submit all energy assistance applications, please bring the following documents with you:

- The last 4 weeks of income for all household members (gross income)
If you receive Social Security, please bring your most recent bank statement showing deposit.
- Your most recent complete utility bill (If heat is included in the rent, please bring a copy of the lease showing heat is included.
- If you heat with a deliverable fuel, please provide the name of your fuel vendor (and acct number if you have it)
 - Your unemployment history prints out (if applicable)
- Documentation of Child support, alimony, and pension for the last four weeks if applicable.
 - Amount of rent or mortgage (no letter or statement is required)
 - Bring 1099 from 2023 for pension annuity or 401K.
