NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN of a public hearing to be held by the East Lyme Board of Selectmen at 7:00 p.m. on April 16, 2025, at the East Lyme Town Hall, 108 Pennsylvania Avenue, Niantic, Connecticut to consider the following:

1. To revise the Ordinance § 51.17 entitled "Fees for Disposal of Waste at the Transfer Station" to remove the public hearing requirement.
2. To revise the Transfer Station Fees in accordance with Ordinance § 51.17 "Fees for Disposal of Waste at the Transfer Station" as proposed by the Director of Public Works.
3. To repeal the Ordinance § 51.55 entitled "Fees for Disposal of Waste at Landfill" because the landfill was closed and capped more than 30 years ago.

Existing Ordinance

The Board of Selectman can update that schedule at any time upon notice and a hearing. The schedule of fees as of the effective date of the current version of this subchapter is posted at the Roxbury Road Transfer Station and on the Public Works section of the town website.

Proposed Repeal of Landfill Fees Ordinance

Existing Ordinance

§ 51.55 FEES FOR DISPOSAL OF WASTE AT LANDFILL.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board of Selectmen, the following schedule of fees for the disposal of waste at the town landfill is established, to become effective upon publication.

Asphalt and non-reinforced concrete, per 100 lbs.	\$1
Automobile and light truck tires (each)	\$1.50
Brush	\$40.00 portion, applied as follows:
For each 20 pound multiple or portion thereof as defined by the town's weighing system	\$0.40
Demolition material including waste from remodeling and construction projects and sites, and all oversize household items and tree stumps	\$110 per ton applied as follows:
Minimum charge	\$5
Per each 20 pound multiple or portion thereof as determined by the town's weighing system	\$1.10
Heavy truck tires (each)	\$5
Refrigeration appliances containing CFCs (non-commercial only)	\$10 each
Tires from earth-moving equipment (each)	\$100
