Secretary's Minutes of the Previous Annual Meeting July 8, 2024:

Minutes from the previous annual meeting of July 8, 2024, were distributed. Molly Helms moved these minutes be accepted, Christie Hayes seconded. Motion passed.

<u>Treasurer's Annual Report:</u> John Makiaris reported that the library's annual report is in good shape and confirmed that there are sufficient resources to operate through the next fiscal year. Lisa added, she organized several line items in Quick Books to streamline the auditing process.

<u>Director's State of the Library 2025 report:</u> Lisa briefly reported the following:

Due to increased costs in health insurance and pension, the library had fewer funds to work with in FY25. To meet FY26 expenses, an 11% increase was initially requested from the town. Discussions were held with the Town Finance Director, and all necessary steps were taken to ensure health insurance costs remained within budget. The final approved FY26 budget reflects a 6.3% increase over the previous fiscal year.

In September, the library faced two censorship challenges related to the book "Gender Queer". Established protocols were followed to address and resolve the concerns appropriately.

The state legislature passed a new eBook law aimed at addressing the high prices publishers charge libraries for digital content.

The Library of Things launched in May 2025. Circulation has been steady, and the collection is expected to grow over the coming year.

The library's first cosplay Comic Con event was a success. It will return this year under the new name "Library Con."
