I am writing in response to a request for an intermunicipal referral for the Town of East Lyme. The application was received on September 25th. The application was referred to this agency pursuant to Section 8-3(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes.

The proposed amendment seeks to allow for the keeping of chickens in the R-12 and R-10 residential zoning districts. To accommodate this change, it also seeks to require that R-12 and R-10 lots used for this purpose be at least 10,000 square feet.

Based on a review of the material provided, I have determined that the proposed zoning regulation amendment is not likely to have a negative intermunicipal impact.
