HARBOR MANAGEMENT SHELLFISH COMMISSION
September 17, 2013 Informal Discussion

Members Present: Steve Dinsmore, Chairman; Treasurer Don Landers; Secretary Barbara Johnston

1. CALL TO ORDER. Chairman Dinsmore called the informal discussion to order at 7:35 p.m.

2. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF August 29, 2013. This matter was tabled.

3. PUBLIC DELEGATIONS. Mr. Theiler thanked Mr. Hitchery for the terrific job he has done as Harbor Master.

Mr. Theiler submitted a letter that due to the present market conditions, he is unable to renew his lease with the Town of East Lyme.

Mr. Landers stated he appreciated Mr. Theiler's efforts.

4. REPORTS

A. Shellfish There was no report on shellfish.

B. Harbor Master Mr. Hitchery reported there are 266 paid moorings and \$6,900 in fees have been collected. There are three individuals whose moorings he recommends not renewing. He thanked Mr. Theiler for his help.

Status of Harbor Master Replacement Mr. Formica sent an email to Mr. Dinsmore regarding the appointment of Dick Morris as Harbor Master.

C. Treasurer. Mr. Landers reported we have a bill from Jeanette T. Fisheries in the amount of \$200 for mooring removal, two bills from WELSCO in the amount of \$118.75 for the months of May and June and \$156.25 for patrolling hours for the months of July and August and a bill from the Recording Secretary for 2.50 for the August Meeting.

D. Ex-Officio . Mr. Seery reported at 7 p.m. tomorrow night there will be a Town Meeting on appropriations specified in the Capital Plan.

The Town was awarded \$500,000 in a STEEP Grant towards the Boardwalk. We hope to begin repairs in October or November from Hole-in-the-Wall to Amtrak Beach.

There was discussion on some species of invasive bamboo. The Conservation of Natural Resources was asked to look into it to determine whether or not an ordinance is needed.

Mr. Morris asked if they will erect bath houses at Cini Park? Mr. Seery replied they do not know yet.

Mr. Landers stated two individuals were injured at the pump station. Mr. Seery reported they are now fine.

Mr. Morris reported pump 2 and 3 are on line. The insurance company will have an electrical engineer to test the breaker. Its thirty years old.
