

MINUTES
WORKING MEETING OF HISTORIC PROPERTIES COMMISSION
7:00 p.m., FEBRUARY 16, 2015
EAST LYME POLICE STATION

Present: Mark Christensen, Steve Marks-Hamilton, Chair, Luane Lange. Alternates seated: Elizabeth Murphy, Richard Waterman.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. Luane volunteered to make notes.

The descriptions of the first 41 properties of the By Age, Housing Inventory were distributed, eight properties to each commission member. Also, distributed and discussed were the Review Forms to be used for criteria decisions on "historically significant properties."

After individual reviews were completed, the recommendations of each member were discussed and decisions made. Three properties of these early houses were determined to be "not significant" due to the amount of alterations. (Numbers 28, 31, and 41. Information will be sought on twelve of the accepted properties related to previous owners names, events, etc., to clarify town memories.

Steve suggested using the "Demolished" list in Olive Chendali's Book, East Lyme: Our Town and How It Grew as part of the references included in this inventory.

It was agreed that further review of the Inventory could be done in pieces, working on about thirty houses per meeting.

The meeting adjourned at 8:45 p.m.
