The East Lyme Board of Selectmen will hold a public hearing on

MAY 15 20 1) at 7:00 p.m. at the East Lyme Town Hall, 108

Pennsylvania Avenue, Niantic, CT to consider water conservation measures proposed to be imposed pursuant to the East Lyme Water Supply Emergency Ordinance, as follows:

Water restrictions will be in effect from 9:00 a.m. on Friday through noon on Monday of each week until further notice.

The following restrictions will apply to all customers of the East Lyme Water System:

- 1) Prohibiting the sprinkling, watering or irrigation of lawns.
- 2) Prohibiting washing of motor vehicles and the outdoor surfaces of all buildings and structures, sidewalks and driveways.
- 3) Prohibiting the filling or cleaning of swimming and wading pools.
- 4) Prohibiting the service of water to customers of public restaurants except at the specific request of customers.

Persons found violating any provision of the restrictions imposed by the Board of Selectmen shall be fined not more than ninety-nine dollars (\$99.00). In the case of a continuing violation, each day's continuance thereof shall be deemed to be a separate and distinct offense. These restrictions are effective June 28, 2013 and will remain in effect until further notice.
