James has agreed to provide our town with an early assessment of the property from the point of view of invasive species management. According to all experts the Darrow's committee has worked with, control of invasive species is the most urgent and biggest challenge the town faces in managing the property. James will provide an overview of the service they provide and make some initial recommendations, based on a review of our property.
