

1) The meeting was called to order at 7:30 pm after a quorum established.



- 3) Treasurer's report was accepted, after review of the financials and the July checking account bank reconcilement; including any checks disbursed on a motion by R. Miller, seconded by T. Bowlen; motion passed unanimously. P. Kelly requested the annual depreciation entry be processed and Town grant money request letters be sent.
- 4) Chief Warden's Comments-
  - The clamming areas are currently closed in Niantic and Waterford; recent water samples are good, waiting on meat sample results.
  - New swing back seat for wardens boat installed and working well.
  - A small amount of scallops were found .
  - There is not a clamming sign posted in the Niantic Bay area at the Crescent beach location.

- 6) Old Business- None
- 7) New Business
  - a) Mr. A. Sullivan of Niantic presented concerns regarding the clamming closures and requests for a refund or credit for next season. The members discussed the matter and agreed that no refunds or credits will be issued to permit holders.
  - b) Further discussion of an open scallop season will be tabled until the next meeting.
  - c) Board members discussed sample testing, water quality and sewer spillage issues.
  - d) Some discussion of proposed sewers in Pine Grove and Saunders Point Niantic ensued. Sewers in these areas would have a positive effect on shellfishing areas.
  - e) F. Grimsey asked Don Landers to assist in requesting Amtrak install the Niantic River Bridge welcome sign. The cost of the sign has increased to \$4,600.00
  - f) Transient moorings proposal in Cini Park was discussed.
  - g) A two year plan for bridge construction at Golden Spur has been proposed.
  - h) An idea to survey Keeney Cove and Jordan Cove residents was considered.
  - i) Donations to the commission for a scallop season were reviewed.
