- 1) The meeting was called to order at 7:30 pm after a quorum established.
- 2) The minutes of the June meeting were reviewed and accepted after corrections noted: Peter Harris was not present, and the spelling of E. Kanter's name; on a motion by J. Kelly, seconded by P. Spakowski; L. Tytla abstain, motion passed.
- 3) Treasurer's report was accepted, after review of the financials and the June checking account bank reconcilement; including any checks disbursed on a motion by P. Spakowski, seconded by E. Kanter; motion passed unanimously.
- 4) Chief Warden's Comments-
 - The clamming areas are currently closed, meat samples were high in choloform. The DA/BA is being contacted on the new samples processing time. J. Kelly will contact Ledge Light as to a possible septic/sewage problem near Golden Spur area.
 - Chief still receiving complaints regarding demarcation sign; he added a new anchor.
 - Some small scallops have been found.
 - The cost to replace the warden's seat/cooler is higher than originally expected as the swingback bar is attached and was not part of the original replacement cost approved.

Motion 1: To purchase a seat/cooler/ with swingback (large deluxe Todd model) from Defenders at a cost of \$460.00 for the warden's boat was made by E. Kanter, seconded by P. Spakowski, all in favor.
