REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

1. Application of the Town of East Lyme Parks & Recreation Department for a Special Permit and Coastal Area Management Site Plan Review to construct a new beach support building, with bathrooms, at property identified in the application as 8 Atlantic Street (aka McCook's Park) Assessor's Map 11.4, Lot 175

Chairman Salerno reminded the members that the applicant has requested a waiver for the buffer, and for the landscaping. This will be a nice addition to the park.

Motion (1) Mr. Peck moved to approve the application of the Town of East Lyme Parks and Recreation Department for a Special Permit and Coastal Area Management Site Plan Review to construct a new beach support building, with bathrooms, at property identified in the application as 8 Atlantic Street (aka McCook's Park) Assessor's Map 11.4, Lot 175 with the two waivers added for the sidewalk landscaping and buffer.

Reasons:

- 1. Application is consistent with all applicable goals and conditions of the CAM Act.
- 2. Applicant has taken all reasonable measures to mitigate any adverse impacts of the proposed activity on both coastal resources and future water dependent uses.

Seconded by Mr. Donovan.

Motion Passed 6-0.

Mr. Mulholland stated this will be published next Thursday, February 23, 2012 and will be effective February 24, 2012.

Chairman Salerno stated the Town did have to pay \$60.00 to the State for the Application.

2. Application of Gerry Karpuska, for a Special Permit for Outdoor Dining at property identified in the application as 26 W Main Street, Niantic, Connecticut. Assessor's Map 11.2, Lot 17.

**Mr. Peck recused himself for Item 2, and Mr. Dwyer sat in his seat.

Chairman Salerno stated this is a one year permit, and the open hours will be until 9:00 p.m. Sunday through Thursday, and until 10:00 p.m. Friday and Saturday. The outdoor lights will go off at those closing times. Some places we have allowed outdoor music, but it will be up to the Commission if this would be an appropriate location.

Mr. Mulholland stated downtown is more commercialized, this is more residential.

Mr. Dwyer stated he doesn't know how they would define low music.

Mr. Walker stated this is renewable every year.

Chairman Salerno stated if they approve this and they get complaints they can re-address the issue. There will be no live music.

Motion (2) Mr. Donovan moved to approve the application of Gerry Karpuska, for a Special Permit for Outdoor Dining at property identified in the application as 26 W Main Street, Niantic, Connecticut. Assessor's Map 11.2, Lot 17.

Conditions:

- 1. Entertainment allowed is only as low level background music.
- 2. Hours of operation of patio Sunday through Thursday until 9:00 p.m. and Friday and Saturday until 10:00 p.m.

Seconded by Mr. McPherson.

Mr. McPherson suggested they add when the lights should be turned off.

**Mr. Donovan amended his Motion to read the following:

Conditions:

1. Entertainment allowed is only as low level background music.

2. Hours of operation of patio Sunday through Thursday until 9:00 p.m. and Friday and Saturday until 10:00 p.m.

Lighting on the deck will be in operation until said closing times.

Seconded by Mr. McPherson.
