1. <u>APPLICATION OF TODD SAKOWSKI, TO AMEND THE EAST LYME ZONING REGULATIONS SECTION 1.79, 9.2.10, 20.20.8 AND 25.5 TO PERMIT THE OPERATION OF A TAPROOM BREWERY</u>

Mr. Dwyer suggested we investigate other towns that have breweries, he did research online and there was some information about obnoxious odors. He would like to find out more.

Mr. Donovan stated the applicant mentioned the odor from spent grain, and that would be taken away daily from Cranberry Meadow Farm.

Mr. Dwyer stated he would like to look at the zoning regulations in other towns.

Mr. Donovan stated they would have to come for a Special Permit anyway.

Mr. Mulholland stated the next meeting is July 9th, the applicant can provide us with additional information, and the Commission could possibly go visit other breweries.

Mr. Peck stated the alternate would be a one year permit.

Mr. Mulholland stated the one year permit creates anxiety and risk to the applicant. This is a big financial commitment.

Mr. Donovan stated he understands the concerns about odor. He would like to get more information and see the final re-wording of the proposed amendment.

Mr. Mulholland stated he can sit down with the applicant and this can be continued to the July 9th meeting. He wants to move forward in September. We could possibly have a Special Meeting to help him out.

Chairman Walker stated this is a unique application and we want to do our due diligence. We will continue this to the July 9th meeting.

2. <u>APPLICATION OF JULIE SMART, FOR SMARTY'S, FOR A SPECIAL PERMIT FOR OUTDOOR DINING</u>
AT PROPERTY IDENTIFIED IN THE APPLICATION AS 215 MAIN STREET, NIANTIC
